Memory foam mattress with **hook and loop** receptor sheet.

The **central actuator** allows 360° access to the child, providing 40cm/16" height adjustment, and back recline up to 50°.
- 3

20° **tilt-in-space** provides a comfortable position to improve pressure re-distribution, or to aid therapy time such as the Reverse Trendelenberg posture post feeding.

Two inclinometers, one for back recline and one for tilt in space provide quantifiable **outcome measures** enabling individual angles to be documented and easily replicated.

The Support Pack is a popular suite of brackets and cushions used to support the child in prone, side-lying and supine postures. Used with our SymmetriSleep system but with wipeable red covers, the Support Pack is quick and easy to use, and ensures that **nighttime positioning can be carried over to daytime**.

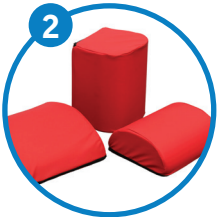
The Bumper Pack provides **increased support** in side lying for taller/heavier users.

Adjustable Side & Prone Table: For **enhanced functionality**, ideal for keyboards, laptops and books, now with a non-slip table surface.

The Airmantle is a pressure re-distribution layer with breathable top and waterproof polyurethane base that can be placed on top of the memory foam mattress for **extra comfort and protection**. This is particularly good for someone who is in the Acheeva for extended periods.

A CoolOver removable sheet. CoolOver fabric enhances thermal comfort with Omnitherm® microcapsules that absorb and release heat to **maintain an even temperature**. The soft hypoallergenic material offers excellent air permeability and moisturewicking properties, **reducing respiratory stress** and keeping you cooler and dryer.

Classroom versatility with multi-position capabilities

Being part of a 24-hour postural management programme is the optimum approach to protect body shape, but this can be difficult to achieve for every child.

During the school day, students need breaks from their seats to work on motor skills and postural control, but being on the floor can result in safety issues for staff and student.

Safe working height for staff

- Educational, medical and therapeutic activities such as changing dressings, or lower limb stretches, which previously took place on mats on the floor can now be carried out on the Acheeva, enhancing safety for students and reducing strain on staff members' backs and knees.



Decreased need for hoist transfers
